Chapter 3: Ghosts in the Machine: Secrets and Surprises of Electronic Documents

2. Write a 3-2-1:
 - a. Describe three things you learned. Do not just list the topics! Explain three things you learned from the reading, as if you were trying to pass this knowledge along in your own words.
 - b. Formulate two questions inspired by the reading.
 - c. Tell me one thing that surprised you, amused you, or fascinated you in the reading.
3. Answer the following questions:
 - a. The text is 10 years old now. Identify at least one situation described in the chapter that has been overtaken by new technology in the years since the book was first published.
 - b. When a hard drive is erased, are its contents really gone? What happens when a file is deleted? What happens when you “empty the trash” on your computer?
